Ticket Information

- * The cost for Beaver Local juniors and seniors to attend prom is **\$55** for a single or **\$110** for a couple. Cash or check accepted, checks should be made out to BLHS or Beaver Local High School. Add an extra **\$10** if you are bringing a non BLHS student.

- * Beaver Local sophomores may attend as the date of a Beaver Local HS junior or senior. Freshmen are not permitted to go to prom under any circumstances!

- * Sophomore, junior, or senior students from other schools, or individuals 20 years old and younger, **and** a high school graduate within the past two years, may attend as a date of a BLHS junior or senior for **\$120** per couple.

- * All forms will be checked and cleared before any visiting guest may attend. Students under suspension or expulsion from ANY school may not attend.

- * **All required forms must be completed and turned in when purchasing tickets regardless of school of attendance or age of guest!**

- * Tickets will be on sale Monday, March 11th through Friday, March 22nd - Before and after school in Mrs. Speece's room 21. **NO EXTENSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS!**

- * **Due to prepayment of catering and other services, there will be NO REFUNDS!**

GRAND MARCH
Rules for Students and Audience

- Students will report to the gym no later than 4:30 p.m. Formal pictures will be taken in the auditorium immediately following grand march. Picture packets may be picked up when purchasing tickets.
- **Parents and guests will not be permitted in the gym at any time!** Please take your pictures at home before coming to school.
- Students will begin line-up for grand march at 4:45 p.m. in the hallway behind the gym. (An adult will direct you)
- Parents and guests are to be seated in the gym by 4:45 p.m. in order to start grand march on time and get students to the prom site in time for dinner. Be aware that traffic will be congested and parking at the high school is limited. Give yourself enough time to park and get to the gym in time!
- **There is an admission charge of \$1.00 per person to view the Grand March.**
- Once parents and guests are seated in the gym, they must ***REMAIN IN THEIR SEATS*** until grand march is over. Please respect the fact that all guests have the right to enjoy the march, regardless of when their child appears! Students will be loading the buses as soon as they exit the auditorium. Parents will not be able to interrupt the flow.
- Please do not block the gym doors or aisles. Couples will be entering and exiting these doors during grand march. Fire codes will not permit attendees to stand in aisles or near doors.
- Staff members will have storage tubs in the gym for cameras, purses and other personal items so you will not have to carry them through grand march. You can pick up your belongings **AFTER** you load the bus. If your belongings are not in the bin, you will not be permitted to bring them with you. As always, items will be searched during grand march. Staff reserves the right to use school breathalyzer as needed.
- **The driveway must be kept clear** so that the buses may pull through and park to load the students. **Do not park outside the marked spaces.**

RULES FOR PROM AND AFTER PROM

1. This is a formal dance, therefore formal attire is required.
2. **ALL RULES IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK WILL APPLY TO BOTH STUDENTS AND GUESTS.**
3. Age for prom date is restricted to persons who have graduated from high school in the last two years **AND** are 20 years or younger, or are of sophomore status.
4. Once you have arrived, you must enter and remain in the building until boarding the buses for home.
5. Beaver Local reserves the right to require students with special needs to provide their own chaperone/transportation for both prom and/or after prom.
6. There will be no tobacco products of any kind at the Prom or after-prom. This includes guest who are older or out of school.
7. Any student or guest shall not possess, use, transmit, sell, or be under the influence of any alcohol or drug of any kind.
8. Students may be checked with a Breathalyzer at any time, and bags and purses WILL be searched.
9. All chaperones reserve the right to ban students from after prom due to bad behavior at prom.
10. Students should bring spending money for food and souvenirs at after-Prom.
11. If you need medication of any kind at Prom or After-prom, (including prescription and all over-the-counter meds such as Tylenol, Midol, etc.) the guidelines in the student handbook must be followed **TO THE LETTER**. See copy on following page.

Please note: Anyone failing to pass the sobriety checks or should anything illegal be found, the deputies on the premises will be alerted and the situation handed over to them!

MEDICATIONS (BLHS POLICY)

According to the Ohio Revised Code, no medications (prescriptions or over-the-counter) can be given at school without the following information:

- A. A written request form (5330FI) obtained from the assistant principal's office and completed by the parent and physician in order for the medication to be administered at school. This form must be filed in the principal's office before the student may begin taking the medication.
- B. Name, dose, purpose for medication, time to be administered, and side effects of the medication.
- C. Physician's signature for the administration of the medication.
- D. Medication must be in the original container.

FORMS

You must have a completed packet for both you and your date! (Even if your date is from another school or has graduated) Paperwork **must be fully completed** and turned in on the day tickets are purchased. They include:

- a. Information and permission slip (one for each person attending).
- b. Early dismissal forms (if a BLHS student - students from other schools must make arrangements with their school).
- c. Emergency medical authorization form (for both individuals regardless of age).
- d. Menu choice (for both individuals).
- e. T-shirt form with size.
- f. After prom form (for both individuals).

IF THESE ITEMS ARE NOT TURNED IN AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE, WE WILL NOT ISSUE YOUR TICKETS!

BUS ASSIGNMENTS

- a. Busing will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis in the order tickets are purchased.
- a. School buses will be used for transportation to and from the both the Prom and After-prom.
- a. Bus information will be posted once all tickets have been purchased and processed.

There will be no rearrangement of seating permitted!!! Do not even ask!
