



## RESOLUTION NO. M-011419

### **A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THIS SCHOOL DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF RENEWING A TAX LEVY FOR THE EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Beaver Local School District (the “School District”), County of Columbiana, and State of Ohio:

Section 1 – Findings and Determinations. This Board makes the following findings and determinations:

- a) This Board adopted its Resolution No. M-121018 (the “Resolution of Necessity”) on December 10, 2018, declaring it necessary to renew its emergency tax levy (the “Tax Levy”).
- b) The Columbiana County Auditor has certified to this Board that the annual average property tax levy required to raise \$1,200,000 annually throughout the life of the Tax Levy, 4.618 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to forty six and eighteen one hundredths.
- c) This Board determines to proceed with submitting the question of the renewal of the additional tax levy to the electors of this School District at the May 7, 2019 general election.
- d) All formal actions of this Board relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2 – Board of Elections Filing. This Board authorizes and directs the Treasurer of this Board to file with the Columbiana County Board of Elections a copy of this resolution, a copy of the Resolution of Necessity, and a copy of the County Auditor’s certification as to the annual property tax levy. This Board requests the Board of Elections to prepare the ballots and make other necessary arrangements for the submission of these questions to the electors of the School District, all in accordance with law.

Section 3 – Effective Date. This resolution shall be in force and in effect immediately upon its adoption.
